Date: Saturday, July 16, 2011

Site: Lake Acworth, Acworth, GA

Time: Registration closes at 7:30 a.m.
The 1-Kilometer (.63 miles) swim starts at 11:00 am.
The 3-Kilometer (1.9 miles) swim starts at 10:00 am.
The 5-kilometer (3.1 miles) swim starts at 8:00 a.m.
See the order of events for complete check-in and starting times.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 and \$10.00 each additional event, up to three events totaling \$50.00
Out of state residents add \$5.00 to entry fee

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by July 14th, 2011 *Late entry and race day entries add \$5.00 to entry fee*
Late entries will be accepted on the day of the swim until 10:30 a.m.

Eligibility: Open to all USA-Swimming members.

--ORDER OF EVENTS & SCHEDULE--

5 Kilometer Swim

Check-in closes: 7:30 am. Pre-race Meeting: 7:40 am. Event start: 8:00 am. Awards presentation: 11:45 am.
Masters, Open, USA-S Senior and 13-14: The race will consist of 2 loops around the long leg of an "L" shaped course marked every 250 meters with buoys.

3 Kilometer Swim

Check-in closes: 9:30 am. Pre-race Meeting: 9:40 am. Event start: 10:00 am. Awards presentation: 11:45 am.
Masters, Open and USA-S 11-12: The race will consist of one loop around the "L" shaped course marked every 250 meters with buoys.

1 Kilometer Swim

Check-in closes: 10:30 am. Pre-race Meeting: 10:40 am. Event start: 11:00 am. Awards presentation: 11:45 am.
Masters, Open and USA-S 10 & Under: The race will consist of a 1K out and back loop marked every 100 meters with buoys.

--RULES & REGULATIONS--

2011 USA-Swimming rules, regulations and safety requirements will be enforced for the well-being of our swimmers. Age as of July 16, 2011 will determine your age group. USMS individual event age groups begin with 18-24, then proceed by age groups (25-29, 30-34...100+) increasing in 5-year increments. Please complete the entry information, **including registration number, date of birth, and club affiliation.**

Sanctioned by Georgia LSC for USA-Swimming Inc.

- **All swimmers who have not completed the course by 12:45 pm, will be disqualified and escorted off the course.**
- **Swimmers may enter 1 or 2 events. Those entering 2 events may enter the 1-K and the 3-K OR the 1-K and 5-K.**

--DIRECTIONS TO VENUE--

From Atlanta- Taking I-75. – Take the Glade Rd exit, exit #278 towards Acworth. Turn LEFT onto Glade Road. Turn RIGHT onto Lake Acworth Dr. NW/Lake Acworth Dr./GA-92. Take the ramp towards Acworth. Turn RIGHT onto Old 41 Highway NW/GA-293. Turn RIGHT onto Academy St. Turn RIGHT to stay on Academy St. Academy St becomes Beach St NW.
