

Q & A: The Low-Down on the Georgia Games Track & Field Championships

Can I compete in the Georgia Games if I am from out of state (meaning ALL the states in the USA)?

YES! We would LOVE to have you compete, but we do charge a nominal \$5 out of state fee.

Will the Georgia Games provide implements for shot put, discus, and javelin events?

No. The Georgia Games will not provide throwing implements. Competitors must supply their own implements in accordance with USATF Implement Specifications.

Are results posted for previous year's competitions?

Yes, go to "2010 Results" at the bottom of the Georgia Games Track & Field page.

Since the Georgia Games is sanctioned by USATF, do I have to be a member to compete?

No, EVERYONE (in the USATF age divisions for youth/open/master) can compete!! Our meet is open to USATF members, AAU members, and unattached.

Are the Track & Field events hand timed or F.A.T?

F.A.T (Fully Automatic Timing)

If my child is too young to comply with the USATF age divisions for a certain event, can he/she compete in the Georgia Games?

Sorry but no. Since we are a sanctioned event, competitors will comply with the USATF age divisions and events as seen here: <http://www.usatf.org/groups/youth/ageDivisions.asp>.

What time will the Race Walk be held? And for what age groups?

The Race Walk (1500, 3000) will be at 7:30am, Sunday, July 17. The competition will be ALL age divisions (youth/open/masters).
